Survey results

- 25 responses on housing
- Most wished for affordable homes & 'retirement' (downsizing) homes
- Blocks of flats NOT wanted
- 10 asked for larger shop, small business properties/cafe

Suggestions

- Thorpe's listed building styles feature dormer windows, red bricks, some timber framing, hung tiling. Can this be adapted for modern living?
- Single/double occupancy properties could be sympathetically done using a 'terrace' style of joined 1½ storey units (see pictures)
- Build in small groups with varied roof lines and facades
- Build large 'house' & divide in four.



Examples

- Rooks Orchard
- Trumps Mill style, could be apartments designed like this, using mixed facades
- A range in Windsor Great Park –could be for living or shop/cafe
- Small groups
